Acquisitions

Herndon-based software development company **10Pearls** said it has acquired Centreville-based information security consultancy **Gemini Security Solutions**. Terms were not disclosed.

Bethesda-based hotel real estate investment trust **RLJ Lodging** said it has closed on its previously announced acquisition of the 231-room Hilton Cabana Miami Beach for \$76 million.

Bethesda-based defense and aerospace giant **Lockheed Martin** said it will acquire California-based Deposition Services, a producer of optical film coatings, from Advanced Lighting Technologies. Terms were not disclosed.

District-based **Graham Holdings** said that its Kaplan education and test prep company has acquired San Francisco-based software developer Dev Bootcamp. Terms were not disclosed.

Expansion

New York-based title insurance and settlement company **Kensington Vanguard National Land Services** said it has opened offices in Woodbridge and Stafford.

Rockville-based IT services company **Dataprise** said it has signed a lease for an additional 23,000 square feet of space at its headquarters and plans to hire an additional 30 employees for its remote support and cloud center.
